

Atlantic Area Training Seminar – Northern Ireland and Ireland partners meet in Dublin
Monday 18th January

The BMW Regional Assembly in conjunction with the Special EU Programmes Body (SEUPB) organised a training seminar in the European Public Information Centre, Dublin for approved project partners from Ireland and Northern Ireland in the INTERREG IVB, Atlantic Area Programme.

Chaired by Gerry Finn of the BMW Regional Assembly, the main focus of the seminar was to inform project partners of the claims process and how to fill in the Execution Report. Jean Luc Fres from the Secretariat of the Atlantic Area gave detailed explanations on the different sections of the claim and specified what information and documentation was required to complete each section.

Michael O'Brien (BMW Regional Assembly) and Teresa Lennon (SEUPB) gave an overview of the Atlantic Area participation in Ireland and Northern Ireland whilst Joe Flynn (BMW Regional Assembly) and Helen Clarke (SEUPB) gave presentations on the First Level of Control in their respective regions.
