

## PEACE III

### Monthly Progress Report to Programme Monitoring Committee

#### 1.0 Introduction

It was agreed at the third meeting of the PEACE III Programme Monitoring Committee, 22 October 2008, that monthly progress reports would be provided to members. This is the tenth of these reports and is for the period up to 31 January 2010.

#### 2.0 Overview

A total of 318 applications have been received for the PEACE III Programme. To date, 113 projects have been recommended for approval with a combined value of €164,796,592.74. There have been 103 Letters of Offer issued with a combined value of €150,435,222.94. N+2 targets were met for 2009 and the current level of expenditure in the programme is €21.9m. The N+2 target for 2010 is €65.5m.

#### 3.0 Progress on Implementation

##### 3.1 Building Positive Relations at the Local Level (€90-100 million)

Letters of Offer for all 14 Local Peace Action Plans have been issued. The total allocation for the Action Plans to date is €50.2m. A total of €4,024,735 in expenditure has been recorded on the database as of 31 January 2010. Table 1 below presents the approved applications under this theme.

### 3.2 Building Positive Relations at the Local Level (Regional) (€40 – 50 million)

A total of 61 applications have been received, 21 of these were received throughout the second call for applications which closed on 13 November 2009. Twenty One Letters of Offer have been issued to date (13 relating to Conflict Transformation from the Bottom Up application) to the value of €26.3m as outlined in the table below. A total of €4,146,855 has been recorded as expenditure on the database as of 31 January 2010. Seventeen applications have been rejected, two withdrawn and one deferred.

#### 4.0 Acknowledging and Dealing with the Past (€50 million)

This theme is implemented by the Consortium of the Community Relations Council and Pobal. By the end of January 2010, 143 applications have been received across the three strands, with 58 approved, 53 rejected, 14 withdrawn and 18 still under assessment. Letters of Offer have been issued to 55 projects at a value of €22.2m and 45 projects have processed their first claims. A total of €4,393,603 has been recorded as expenditure on the database as of 31 January 2010.

This theme is implemented in three strands as outlined below:

##### 4.1 Strand 1 - Addressing the Past in Public Memory

The Consortium invited Expressions of Interest (EOI) for Strand 1 through public advertisement during the week ending 3 October 2008, with a submission deadline of 7 November 2008. 44 EOIs were received requesting a total value of €37m. A call for full applications opened on 8 April 2009 and closed on 29 May 2009. Twenty-six applications were received to the value of approximately €32.5m and assessment of these is ongoing.

##### 4.2 Strand 2 – Support for Participation

Fifty-two applications have been received with a total value of €34.2m. Thirty applications with a combined value of €10.9m have been recommended for approval.

Twenty-seven applications under this strand have been issued with a Letter of Offer to the value of €8.8m.

The Managing Authority, in conjunction with the Consortium, is currently in the process of commissioning an evaluation of the implementation of Theme 1.2 to date. This study will make recommendations in relation to future calls for applications that are planned for later this year.

## 5.0 Priority 2, Theme 1: Creating Shared Space (€82 million)

A total of 61 applications have been received, 31 of these were received through the second call for applications which closed on 13 November 2009. Nine applications have

been recommended for approval by Steering Committee to the value of €53.3m and eight Letters of Offer (LoO) have been issued to date to the value of €48.3m. A total of €5,407,281 has been recorded as expenditure on the database as of 31 January 2010. Table 5 below presents the approved applications under theme 2.1.

## 6.0 Priority 2, Theme 2: Key Institutional Capacities (€40 million)

A total of 39 full applications have been received to date under this theme. Fifteen were received under Area 1 and 24 under Area 2. Thirty-seven applications have been considered by Steering Committee. Two applications have been deferred and will return to Steering Committee at a later date. Twenty-five applications have been rejected and two withdrawn. Eleven applications have been approved to the value of €10.6m with five Letters of Offer issued with a total value of €3.4m. A total of €37,096 has been recorded as expenditure on the database as of 31 January 2010.

### Area 1: Piloting Innovative Service Delivery Models

Fifteen full applications have been considered under Area 1. Three of these have been issued with a Letter of Offer. A further three have been recommended for approval, seven applications have been rejected, one withdrawn and one application has been deferred and will return to Steering Committee at a later date.

## 7.0 Steering Committee Meetings

One Steering Committee has taken place since the last monthly report in November 2009. This Steering Committee was held on Thursday 17 December 2009 to consider the applications received in relation to Strand 1 of Theme 1.2.

## 8.0 Expenditure to date

The Central Payments Unit of SEUPB has issued payments to projects, as of 31 January 2010, for £21,822,739.60 and €8,106,343.00. The expenditure to 31 January 2010 is €21,919,459 and is set out in table 10 below.

## 9.0 Summary

As of 31 January 2010, 113 applications have been approved by Steering Committees. The value of those approved applications total €164.8m. To date, 103 Letters of Offer (13 to Conflict Transformation from the Bottom Up application under 1.1 Regional) have been issued to successful Lead Partners to the total value of €150.4m.
