

PEACE III

Monthly Progress Report to Programme Monitoring Committee

1.0 Introduction

It was agreed at the third meeting of the PEACE III Programme Monitoring Committee, 22 October 2008, that monthly progress reports would be provided to members. This is the eighth of these reports and is for the period up to 31 August 2009.

2.0 Overview

A total of 266 applications have been received for the PEACE III Programme. To date, 104 projects have been recommended for approval with a combined value of €155.7m. There have been 92 Letters of Offer issued with a combined value of €149.6m.

3.0 Progress on Implementation

3.1 Building Positive Relations at the Local Level (€90-100 million)

The position remains as:

Letters of Offer for all 14 Local Peace Action Plans have been issued. The total allocation for the Action Plans to date is €50.2m. Table 1 below presents the approved applications under this theme.

3.2 Building Positive Relations at the Local Level (Regional) (€40 – 50 million)

A total of 40 applications have been received with 39 of these being considered at Steering Committee. To date, the Steering Committee has approved a total of €26.5m to the projects detailed in Table 2 below. A total of 21 Letters of Offer have been issued (13 relating to Conflict Transformation from the Bottom Up application).

A call for applications under this theme opened on Tuesday 1 September 2009 and will close at 5:00pm on Friday 13 November 2009.

4.0 Acknowledging and Dealing with the Past (€50 million)

This theme is implemented by the Consortium of the Community Relations Council and Pobal. By the end of August 2009, the Steering Committee for Theme 1.2 has recommended 55 applications for approval with a total value of €22.2m. Fifty-two Letters of Offer have been issued to the value of €21.2m.

Note: Variations in amounts previously reported reflect negotiations that have occurred between the time of Steering Committee recommendations and issue of Letter of Offer.

This theme is implemented in three strands as outlined below:

4.1 Strand 1 - Addressing the Past in Public Memory

The position remains as:

The Consortium invited Expressions of Interest (EOI) for Strand 1 through public advertisement during the week ending 3 October 2008, with a submission deadline of 7 November 2008. 44 EOIs were received requesting a total value of €37m. A call for full applications opened on 8 April 2009 and closed on 29 May 2009. Twenty-six

applications were received to the value of approximately €32.5m. Decisions on these are expected in the autumn.

4.2 Strand 2 – Support for Participation

Fifty-two applications have been received with a total value of €34.2m. Twenty-seven applications with a combined value of €8.8m have been recommended for approval.

Twenty-four applications under this strand have been issued with a Letter of Offer to the value of €7.8m.

5.0 Priority 2, Theme 1: Creating Shared Space (€2 million)

A total of 30 applications have been received, all have been considered by the Steering Committee with 20 rejected and 1 withdrawn. Nine of those were recommended for approval by Steering Committee to the value of €53.4m and eight Letters of Offer (LoO) have been issued to date. Table 5 below presents the approved applications under theme 2.1.

A call for applications under this theme opened on Tuesday 1 September 2009 and will close at 5:00pm on Friday 13 November 2009.

6.0 Priority 2, Theme 2: Key Institutional Capacities (€40 million)

A total of 39 full applications have been received to date under this theme. Fifteen were received under Area 1 and 24 under Area 2. Twenty-two applications have been considered by Steering Committee with 17 still to be considered, 15 have been rejected and 2 withdrawn. Five applications have been recommended for approval and all have been issued with a Letter of Offer.

Area 1: Piloting Innovative Service Delivery Models

Fifteen full applications have been considered under Area 1. Three of these have been issued with a Letter of Offer as seen in table 6 below. Seven applications still have to be considered by the Steering Committee, four applications were rejected and one was withdrawn.

The Central Payments Unit of SEUPB has issued payments to projects, as of 31 August 2009, for £7,890,914.26 and €2,194,177.94, which now includes reconciled Technical

Assistance. The issued payments include advance payments to projects which still need to be vouched and verified in order to become expenditure. The expenditure to date is £1,268,761.59 and €717,855.92.

9.0 Summary

As of 31 August 2009, 104 applications have been approved by Steering Committees. The value of those approved applications total €155.7m. To date, 92 Letters of Offer (13 to Conflict Transformation from the Bottom Up application under 1.1 Regional) have been issued to successful Lead Partners to the total value of €149.6m.
