Closed to the public for health and safety concerns in 2015, Rathmullan Abbey in Donegal re-opened to the public again in December 2020 after significant restoration work, allowing the public to enjoy the historic abbey and its adjoining graveyard once more.

The project was commissioned as part of the Shared Spaces and Services element of the Council's PEACE IV Local Authority Action Plan, receiving €45,000 to undertake the much needed work.

The conservation works involved the timely removal of trees and ivy and the consolidation of stonework, utilising a lime based mortar matching the existing structure.

It can now be used as a Reimagined Space by members of the public.
