The Monaghan Peace Campus will create a new shared community space, comprising a four-storey community building in the centre of Monaghan town.

The building will include: a Cultural Heritage Centre, Library, Youth Facility, Shared Community Multi-Functional Space, External Community Space and Underground Parking.

The impact of COVID-19 impacted the ability for contractors to get onsite, however despite restrictions, works have been ongoing since July 2020 and continued to follow COVID-19 health measures and restrictions (closing from 8 January 2021 - 4 May 2021).

Works completed to date include:

- Temporary Safety Barriers installed along North Road;
- Culvert and associated chamber installed;
- Level 1 podium ramp structure complete;
- Attenuation tanks cast and precast cover slabs placed;
- Electrical switch room cable trench cast;
- Foundations cast and sub-structure masonry walls built to base of new stone walls at Glaslough St;
- Establishment of site compound, office and welfare accommodations;
- Installation of foundation bearing piles and associated mini pilling;
- Erection of Tower Crane and associated foundations;
- Hoarding erected;
- Time Lapse camera installed;
- Liaison with neighbouring residents and Government Departments.
